<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	<p>The organizing member federation may invite FIG member federations in good standing at their discretion, but must invite at least all Member Federations who have gymnasts in the best 12 per individual apparatus from the B Category Challenger Cup Ranking List for Individual Apparatus. In case of a tie at the 12th place for Individual Apparatus competitions, the tie will not be broken.</p> <p>At the first event of the year 2011 the following gymnasts are eligible and must be invited: the federations of the best 12 gymnasts per apparatus from the 2010 Challenger Cup Ranking List. In case of a tie at the 12<sup>th</sup> place, the tie will not be broken.</p>																																
<b>PARTICIPATION AND FIG LICENSE</b>	<p>Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnast' Licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. <b>VISA</b>	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Czech Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to the Czech Republic. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before <b>17 October 2011</b> to the OC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
<b>INSURANCE</b>	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are

	<p>responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The OC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the OC in advance.</p> <p>The OC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own's charge as follows: 10.- € per person/day.</p>

This fine must be paid to the OC by <b>28<sup>th</sup> October 2011</b>.</p> <p>The number of Apparatus Juries (judges' panels) will be decided by the organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for time and line judges).</p> <p>The Apparatus Juries are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw must be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 man and 1 woman). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the TC Presidents concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.</p> <p>For additional judge's requirements see the Specific Judges' Rules.</p>
