VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the South African Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to South Africa (RSA) . The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before O6 November 2012 to the OC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The OC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the OC in advance.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. Port of entry for delegations flying into South Africa is the O.R. Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg. The travel schedule form must be returned to the OC by 06 November 2012.
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transport will be free of charge from/to the O.R. Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg, and the hotel, as well as from/to the hotel and the competition, Training, and Warm-up hall. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the OC by 06 November 2012.
ACCOMMODATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation and meals expenses of their delegation members. The cost per person / night is 50 EURO. At the time of Definitive registration (05 October 2012) 50% of the costs for the accommodation and meals must be paid to the OC. The remainder of the payment must be paid to the OC at the deadline for Nominative registration (06 November 2012). Accommodation Fees are non-refundable after Nominative registration is confirmed (06 November 2012).
FINAL BANQUET	The Final Banquet will be free of charge. All participating delegation members are welcome to attend the Final Banquet.
JUDGES AND JURIES	The participating member federations must send two qualified judges per discipline/event in which they submit entries (i.e. each for AER, RG, TRA, DMT and TUM). All participating judges must have a current valid FIG brevet. Failure to provide judges as mentioned above will result in an OC
	charge of 1500 USD to the federation concerned (non-refundable). This fine must be paid to the OC by 06 November 2012.
