The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the OC by April 1st, 2012 at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis.

The costs for the accommodations must be paid as follow:

At the time of the Definitive registration (1.04.2012) 50% of the accommodation costs must be paid to the OC. Entries without the payment of the 50% of the accommodation costs will be considered as invalid and will be refused. The remaining 50% of the accommodation costs must be paid by April 29th, 2012.

	In case of room cancellations the OC refunds until April 5^{th} , 2012 the complete amount of cancelled rooms. If cancellations arrive later, the OC refunds 50 % of the amount after April 5^{th} , 2012. If cancellations arrive later than April 29^{th} , 2012 no claims of refunds will be accepted.
	The OC will pay for the accommodation expenses for the gymnasts ranked 1-3, per apparatus, <u>competing in the event</u> from: - the 2011 World Championships (if the event takes place <u>before</u> the Olympic Games) / 2012 Olympic Games (if the event takes place <u>after</u> the Olympic Games) - the 2011 World Cup (Category A) Ranking List - the 2011 Challenge Cup (Category B) Ranking List
MEALS	The invited participating federations must pay for the meals expenses of their delegation members (see exception herein below).

FINAL BANQUET	Delegations that book their accommodation through the OC are invited to the Final Banquet.
	Extra tickets for the banquet (€ 35) can be ordered through the OC. The tickets must be paid by April 29 th , 2012. Without payment the order will be cancelled.
	In case of cancellations after April 29 th , 2012 no claims of refunds will be accepted.
FIG TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND EC MEMBER	The FIG Technical Delegate and EC member (if applicable) will be designated by the FIG. The FIG Technical Delegates will serve as Presidents of the Superior Jury.
JUDGES AND JURIES	The Apparatus Jury (or Juries) will be composed as follows:
	• 2 D judges, minimum 4 E judges, plus 1 Supervisor The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified
	judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and one qualified WAG judge if they participate with female gymnasts.
	Failure to provide judges as mentioned above will result in an OC charge of 2'000 CHF to the federation concerned (non refundable). This fine must be paid to the OC by April 29 th , 2012.

The number of Apparatus Juries (judges' panels) will be decided by the organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for time and line judges).

The Apparatus Juries are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw must be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates.

The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 man and 1 woman). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the TC Presidents concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.

For additional judge's requirements see the Specific Judges' Rules.

ASSIGNMENT OF WORLD CUP POINTS FOR THE RANKING LIST

In principle, the results and the updated FIG World Cup Ranking List will be published on the FIG web site within 24 hours after the end of the competitions provided that all the requirements before and after the competitions are duly respected by the Organizing Member Federation. Separate World Cup Ranking Lists (World Cup and Challenge Cup combined) are established for Individual Apparatus Competitions (i.e. for each apparatus). These lists begin with the first World Cup/Challenge Cup event of the year and end with the last World Cup/Challenge Cup event of the year as follows:
