The Individual Apparatus competition consist of: Qualifications and Apparatus Finals Qualifications: Participation is limited to 3 gymnasts per country on each apparatus. The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to add (two for the qualifications) "hors concours" competitors. These competitors are in addition to the official competitors of the Organizing Member Federation and they cannot qualify for the Finals. They must not appear on the official results list and they will have to start first at every apparatus. The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name a max. of "1 hors concours" competitors in Women's Artistic Gymnastics and a max. of "6 hors concours" gymnasts (i.e. while one "hors concours" gymnast can compete on an apparatus, not more than two "hors concours" gymnast can compete on an apparatus. 	The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation (except for gymnasts and judges). The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members
	(e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.
	The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: \$25.00 USD per person for the all period of stay.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members to the San Juan International Airport (Code: SJU).
	The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by July 1 st , 2013.
LOCAL	Transportation from/to the airport, as well as transportation from/to the hotels
