These gymnasts however will not be eligible for the federation's All Around, Team or Apparatus competitions. These gymnasts will not be eligible for Apparatus finals or African Championship medals. Either gymnast may be subsituted into the team to replace an injured or ill gymnast prior to the start of the event (March-on). They may not replace a team member once the event has begun. Gymnasts within the team of 5, but who are not listed in the federation's start list of competing all apparatus, may compete on the apparatus. However, the gymnast is not eligible for Junior African Championships All Around. The score will also not count into the team if not on the start list for the team competition.

The remainder of the payment must be paid to the OC at the deadline for Nominative registration (17 February 2014).		
	Accommodation Fees are non-refundable after Nominative registration is confirmed (17 February 2014).		
FINAL BANQUET	The Final Banquet will be free of charge. All participating delegation members are welcome to attend the Final Banquet.		
JUDGES AND JURIES	The participating member federations must send three qualified judges per discipline/event in which they submit entries (i.e. each for MAG, WAG and RG). Federations participating with only individual gymnasts in a discipline may provide between 1-2 judges. Federations with Junior and Senior teams may apply to nominate 4 judges. All participating judges must have a current valid FIG brevet.
