| PARTICIPATION | The All-Around World Cup Competitions consist of a "single Final round" competition with no qualifications: <br> - Participation is limited to 8 Gymnasts, plus 1 Wild Card (limited to maximum 1 man and 1 woman). Wild Card gymnasts must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration. <br> - Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF (max. 2 MAG and 2 WAG, incl. Wild Card nominations). <br> - All participating gymnasts are required to compete on all apparatus. <br> - "Wild Card Gymnasts" will receive medals, prize money and World Cup Points. <br> - Until the time of the drawing of lots, in case of gymnasts' withdrawal, the FIG will invite the next eligible gymnasts as per the "replacement policy" outlined in these rules. <br> - Once the draw has been conducted, in case of gymnasts' withdrawal or in case places remain "empty", the Organising Member Federation is entitled to nominate and invite gymnast(s) from its NF or an NF of its choice to fill those "empty" places (limited to maximum 2 gymnasts per $N F$ ). It is understood that such invitations must be made through the respective member federation and that the FIG must be informed. These gymnasts will receive World Cup points, medals and prize money <br> - FIG Competition II rules will be applied for vault. <br> - In case that less than four federations participate, no World Cup points, no medals and no prize money will be given. |

| FEDERATIONS INVITED | The Organizing Member Federation must invite all Member Federations according to the following principles: |

|  | Places 1-8 The top 7 ranked gymnasts in C-II at the previous World <br>  Championships / Olympic Games*. These places are <br> nominative.  <br> The 8 $8^{\text {th }}$ place is reserved for a gymnast from the  <br>  Organizing NF (1 MAG and 1 WAG) only if no athlete from <br> the Organizing NF is qualified or able to confirm their <br> participation. |
|  | The participation of these nominative qualified gymnasts (places 1-7) must be confirmed as soon as possible, but no later than 3 months prior to the competition. Failure to confirm in due time will automatically result in the FIG inviting the replacement as outlined here below. In case a qualified gymnast does not accept to participate in the All-Around World Cup competition or withdraws, he/she is replaced, in order of priority, as follows: <br> - By the next ranked gymnast (places 8-12, nominative places) in C-II at the previous World Championships / Olympic Games*. These places must be confirmed as soon as possible, but no later than 2 months (nominative registration) prior to the competition. <br> - By a gymnast from the best ranked federations in C-IV at the previous World Championships/Olympic Games*. Invitation and selection from these national federations will be done directly by the Organizing Member Federation in consultation with the respective member federation. They must be contacted respecting the ranking order of the results of C-IV of the previous World Championships/Olympic Games. These places are allocated to the National Federation, and must be confirmed as soon as possible, but no later than 2 months (nominative registration) prior to the competition. Organizers of World Cup competitions are obliged to send minimum one male and one female competitor to all All-Around World Cup competitions, if invited according to this replacement rule. |

| SIZE OF DELEGATION AND FIG LICENSE | Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnast' Licenses. | AGE LIMITS | Age Limit for MAG: <br> 18 years (born in 1996 or before for the World Cups taking place in 2014) <br> Age Limit for WAG: <br> 16 years (born in 1998 or before for the World Cups taking place in 2014) |  |  |  |
| JUDGES AND JURIES | The number of Judges' Panels may be decided by the Organizing Member Federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. <br> The Judges' Panels are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw must be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates. The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and one qualified WAG judge if they participate with female gymnasts. <br> Each Judges' Panel must be composed of 2 D judges, min. 5 E judges, plus 1 Supervisor. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for Time and Line Judges). <br> The Organizing Member Federation may apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by 7 November 2014. <br> The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 man and 1 woman). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. <br> Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the TC Presidents concerned will invite these judges at the cost (in terms of international and local travel, accommodation, and meals) of the Organizing Member Federation. These lists begin with the first World Cup event of the Series and end with the last World Cup event of the Series as follows: 2nd Series = four (4) WC events in 2014/2015 <br> The World Cup Points are assigned to the competitors by name. |
