The entry fee is not refundable. Entries without payment of the entry fees will be considered as invalid and will be refused. The LOC will waive the costs for the entry fees for the top three gymnasts per apparatus listed in the World Ranking List.		
ACCREDITATION	The accreditation will take place at the official Hotel of the Tournament, the "Bourbon Ibirapuera Hotel" and will be open from Tuesday, April, 28 <sup>th</sup> till Sunday, May, 03 <sup>rd</sup> 2015.

These competitors are in addition to the official competitors of the Organizing Member Federation, they must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration and they cannot qualify for the Finals.
