If you want to secure a spot for your athletes in the GYMNIX CHALLENGE, you have to register them on AMILIA and to send the Annex 1 to <u>classique@gymnix.ca</u>, attention to: Anne-Maud Jan Viau.

If your gymnast respects at least one of the conditions, you have to follow the instructions to complete the online registration. Take note that only online registration will confirm your athlete's registration in the GYMNIX CHALLENGE, and this must be done before **December 10th, 2014**. You will find attached the technical package for the Gymnix Challenge.

In addition to L'International Gymnix, a competition called **Classic Gymnix** (opened to all provincial and national streams athletes) will be held the same weekend. All the Classic Gymnix information is in this package too. The deadline for registration **is also December 10th, 2014**.

L'International Gymnix will celebrate its 24th anniversary this year, and will welcome once again some of the world's best gymnasts.

Medical Services:	Physiotherapy services will be provided in the warm-up gym and the competition floor; for injuries and emergency taping. A doctor will be on call during the event.


