EVENT FORMAT	Competition format: 5 - 4 - 3 All gymnasts are entitled to a complete individual all-around competition. Gymnasts born 2002 – 2000 will be judged according to FIG CoP junior rules. Gymnasts born 1999 or earlier will be judged according to FIG CoP senior rules. Regardless of the gymnasts' ages (and therefore used rules) all scores will be implemented in the same result list.
