MONTPELLIER, May 23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012

**PROGRAMME**

---

**Juniors**

- competition I, a decisive competition for the team result, the qualification for the all-around competition, the qualification for the apparatus finals,
- competition II, all-around final
- competition III, apparatus finals

**Seniors**

- competition I, qualification for the team finals, the apparatus finals
- competition IV, team finals
- competition III, apparatus finals

**RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE**

---

**Juniors**      maximum 5 gymnasts  
**Seniors**      maximum 5 gymnasts

**AGE**

---

**Juniors**      14 to 18 years (born in 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998)  
**Seniors**      16 years or older (born in 1996 or earlier)

Gymnasts have the right to participate if they reach the determined age during the year of the competition. It is only possible to participate in one category: either senior or junior.

### **PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION**

---

The provisional registration must be received at the Secretariat of the UEG by **December 16, 2011**.

### **DEFINITIVE REGISTRATION**

---

The definitive registration as well as the nominative list of the judges must be received at the Secretariat of the UEG by **February 23, 2012**.

### **NOMINATIVE LIST OF THE GYMNASTS, THE JUDGES AND OF THE OFFICIALS**

---

The nominative list of the gymnasts, the judges and the officials must be received at the Secretariat of the UEG by **May 2, 2012**.

### **FIG LICENCE**

---

All gymnasts must have a FIG licence which has to be presented upon accreditation. All the licences are established by the FIG Office on the basis of the information transmitted by the affiliated Federations.

### **ENTRY FEES**

---

**EURO 100.-** per gymnast.

### **REGULATIONS**

---

The Championships will be organised according to the valid UEG regulations for the European Artistic Gymnastic Team championships.

### **WORK-PLAN**

---

The participating federations will receive the work-plan according to UEG-regulations.

### **JUDGES**

---

A Federation participating in two categories (seniors and juniors) must enter two judges; a Federation participating in one category (seniors or juniors) must enter one judge. A Federation participating with an insufficient number of judges or without judge will have to pay a fine of 1000 Euro to the UEG per missing judge.

All judges must be holders of the FIG licence for the current cycle.

Please take note that the entered judges could be asked to function as "D2" or "E" judge or also as reference judge.

## **PUBLICITY ON THE ATTIRE OF THE GYMNASTS**

---

Federations wishing to display advertising motifs on attires used in competition by gymnasts and/or coaches must notify the UEG Secretariat by completing the enclosed form "Publicity on competition attire". The form must be received at the UEG Secretariat by **May 2, 2012**.

## **FINES FOR LATE ENTRIES**

Please allow us to remind you of the sanctions.

- provisional entry received after the deadline	Euro 1'000.-
- definitive entry without previous provisional entry	Euro 2'000.-
- definitive entry received after the deadline (but within 48 hours before the draw)	Euro 3'000.-
- definitive entry received after the deadline (later than 48 hours before the draw)	participation refused
- nominative entry received after the deadline	Euro 1'000.-
- non-participation of a team but participation of individuals (information at the venue)	Euro 2'000.-
- non-participation of individuals, no participation at all (noticed at the venue)	Euro 2'000.-
- non-participation of a team, no participation at all (noticed at the venue)	Euro 3'000.-
