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



5. PARTICIPATION RIGHT AND ACCREDITATIONS

Senior Gymnasts holding a valid FIG License until the end of the competitions and with the correct age from FIG affiliated federations in good standings may take part in these Individual World Championships. An individual is entitled to only one accreditation card. If an individual has several valid "accreditable" functions, the highest function is normally selected, and no substitutes may directly benefit from unused accreditations. The functions of judge and gymnast cannot be combined with any other function, except for gymnast who can also act as Head of Delegation. It is forbidden to make a change of function after the nominative entry deadline except in case of special authorisation by the FIG Secretary General or his representative. However, it is forbidden for someone with an accreditation to substitute his/her function with the function of gymnast.

Maximum Delegation Size

Each Delegation is requested to submit its Delegation composition through **FIG** on-line registration system.

The maximum size of each delegation, together with the number of transferable access cards (transferable within the Federation's official delegation and for the appropriate function) as per FIG Rules for Accreditation is as follows:

In case of lost or stolen accreditation, the LOC and the FIG must be informed immediately to block the accreditation. Lost or stolen accreditations may be replaced at the charge of the card holder (CAD 270). Lost or stolen transferable access cards will not be replaced.

The FIG Accreditation Rules and Media Rules have to be strictly respected.

6. AGE LIMIT OF GYMNASTS

- The age of the MAG gymnasts in 2017 is minimum 18 years old (born 1999) or older.
- The age of the WAG gymnasts in 2017 is minimum 16 years old (born 2001) or older.

7. REGISTRATIONS AND ENTRY FEES

Registrations can only be made by FIG affiliated federations in good standings.

Each Delegations taking part with 4-6 MAG and/or 4 WAG gymnasts will have the right to present two qualified E-judges in good standing of which one, at least, will be called upon to judge, provided that no R-judge was nominated or D-judge was drawn. The total number of judges per NF may however not exceed 2.

- If 1 R is nominated, then only 1 E can be assigned
- If 1 D is drawn, then only 1 E can be assigned
- If 1 D is drawn, then no R can be nominated

Each Delegations taking part with 1-3 MAG and/or 1-3 WAG gymnasts will have the right to present one qualified E- judge.

Provisional Registration

The provisional registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation via the <u>FIG</u> on-line system (<u>click here</u>) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations' login (e-mail) and password, <u>from 18 April 2017 until 02 May 2017 (until midnight Swiss time)</u> at the very latest.

<u>Note</u>: your Federation is only requested to confirm the maximum 3 gymnasts competing per apparatus at the time of the Nominative Registration.

After the provisional registration, the LOC will provide by email to each Federation, instructions on how to access the **LOC** online system. Using the LOC online system, Federations will be able to:

- Book accommodations and meal plans
- Submit travel schedule information (arrivals and departures)
- Make Visa requests
- Buy additional Farewell Banquet tickets
- Upload photos of each delegation member
- Request insurance coverage

Definitive Registration

The definitive registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation via the <u>FIG</u> on-line system (<u>click here</u>) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations' login (e-mail) and password, <u>from 03 May 2017 until 03 July 2017 (until midnight Swiss time)</u> at the very latest.

<u>Note</u>: although your Federation is only requested to confirm the maximum 3 gymnasts competing per apparatus at the time of the Nominative Registration, the online system nevertheless requires that you register a number already at this Definitive Registration stage.

- Enter "3" for all MAG and WAG apparatus if you register 3 to 6 MAG gymnasts and 3 or 4 WAG gymnasts.
- Enter "2" for all MAG and WAG apparatus if you register 2 MAG gymnasts and 2 WAG gymnasts.
- <u>Enter "1"</u> for all MAG and WAG apparatus if you register 1 MAG gymnast and 1 WAG gymnast This will then allow you to enter your appropriate names at the Nominative Registration.

Nominative registrations received in the FIG Offices after the drawing of lots will be <u>refused</u> (i.e. the gymnasts will not be allowed to compete).

Registrations without the appropriate payment of the registration fees at the time of the Definitive Registration will be considered invalid (i.e. the gymnasts will not be allowed to compete).

Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the FIG (e.g. annual membership fees, unpaid invoices etc.) and the LOC (e.g. hotel accommodation) will not be allowed to participate in these Individual World Championships.

Fines

The fines are as follows (as per FIG TR, Section 1, Reg. 4.1.):

8. LICENSES

The LOC will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnasts' Licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. In order to be considered, Licence application forms (new or renewal) must therefore be submitted on 4 August 2017 at the latest (i.e. one month prior to the deadline for nominative registration). Please consult FIG License Rules for additional information in this respect.

9. JUDGES

The MAG and WAG D (1 and 2) and R Judges will be respectively drawn and designated by FIG.

Each delegation may send MAG and WAG Judges of Category I, II, or III. The MAG and WAG E-judges' draw will be conducted in Montreal in accordance with the provisions of the 2017-2020 FIG General Judges' Rules, including Reg. 7.10.3 a) of the TR.

10. DRAWING OF LOTS

The drawing of lots will decide the starting order of the Qualifications and the Apparatus finals.

The gymnasts' drawing of lots will take place within two weeks after the deadline of the **Nominative** Registration. The exact date, time, and location will be announced in due course by the FIG to the parties concerned which are entitled to be present at the draw.



For these Individual World Championships, the drawing of lots will be conducted to allow each Delegation to train, warm-up and compete together in one group.

11. COMPETITION FORMAT AND PROGRAMME

The Individual World Championships comprise exercises on each of the various apparatus to determine the All-Around World Champion and the World Champion on each apparatus. Qualifications, All-Around Finals, and Apparatus Finals will be organized and conducted according to the 2017 TR, including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastic, Reg. 5.3. There will be no Team Finals or Team Ranking in the Qualifications.

Each Federation may register a maximum of 6 men's gymnasts and 4 women's gymnasts. However, no more than 3 gymnasts may compete per apparatus.



The Provisional training, warm-up, and competition schedules will be included in the work plan. Each Delegation will train, warm-up and compete together in one group at these Individual World Championships.

At these Individual World Championships, the following will be implemented:

- A spectacular mega screen will be installed in a theatre shape Competition Hall and used to enhance each segment of the event experience, the sports presentations and the venue entertainment. The MAG and WAG Apparatus Podiums will be positioned on the Field of Play as shown under point 3 above
- The Judges' panels and Apparatus Supervisor will sit in line outside the Field of Play

- The Floor Exercise Line Judges will sit at each end of the Floor Exercise panels and will be supported by a video system. The Vault Line Judge will be seated on an elevated platform behind the Vault Podium with no special video system. Out of bounds will be signaled through the activation of a red light.
- Gymnasts will be presented by a speaker as they come onto a large stage placed in front of the spectacular screen and will make their way to their apparatus.
- The Federations' flags will be displayed through the spectacular screen at the Opening Ceremony, as part of the pre-show for each Competition Session, for the Victory Ceremony, and at the Closing Ceremony
- The Mixed Zone will be positioned so as to be visible from the Competition Hall

12. BIOGRAPHIES

Athlete biographies are available online at http://www.fig-gymnastics.com/publicdir/licences/lic_view.php and will be updated before the World Championships.

13. PUBLICITY

As the Code of Points foresee deductions should the FIG Rules for Advertising and Publicity on attire and equipment not be respected, each federation may fill-in the online FIG Publicity form (FIG Rules for Advertising and Publicity Appendix E for men and F for women) if deemed necessary by **04 September 2017** at the very latest in order to have it approved.

While the Publicity Rule Chart is available on the FIG website under "Rules - Publicity" for additional information, you may also contact tv@fig-gymnastics.org for further assistance if required.

14. EQUIPMENT

The Manufacturer Supplier will be Gymnova. While the Color of the Floor Exercise mat will be white, please refer to Appendix 1 for the complete List of Apparatus which will be used, including the certified product names and article numbers.

15. VISA

Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Canadian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Canada.

The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the Visa request is made to the LOC via the <u>LOC</u> online system before <u>03 July 2017</u> and includes the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

New Canadian entry requirement now in effect: visa-exempt foreign nationals need an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) to fly to or transit through Canada.

International transportation





The prepayment to the LOC of 50% of the total cost of the accommodation and meal plan (if any) must be made at the time you submit the Accommodation Room Numbers and Meal Plan (if any), or by no later than <u>03 July 2017</u>. 23. WAG MUSIC

While the LOC guarantees the respect for the rights of author and broadcasting of the musical works, each National Gymnastics Federation will also have to confirm that the Floor Exercise music of their WAG gymnast does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcasted within sports. This confirmation will have to be made at the time of the online Nominative Registration via **FIG** online system.

Each National Gymnastics Federation will also be requested to inform on the composer, the title of the music, the artist/interpreter and if words/voice are used.

24. ELECTIONS OF THE MAG AND WAG ATHLETES' REPRESENTATIVES

The elections of the MAG and WAG athletes' representative for the period extending from 2018 until 2021 will take place as follows:

- for MAG: on 06 October 2017 from 17h30-19h00 in a location TBC
- for WAG: on 05 October 2017 from 17h30-19h00 in a location TBC

These elections will be made according to the FIG Statutes and based on the candidatures received. Not more than one representative in the FIG athletes' commission per Federation will be allowed. The assembly of the athletes will be open to two athletes per member federation and FIG officials.

The election will be directed by a person to be designated at a later stage, accompanied respectively by MTC and WTC Presidents.

MAG and WAG Candidates must be nominated by their gymnastics Federation as soon as possible, but by no later than <u>04 September 2017</u>. Should the FIG not receive any candidatures within the given deadline, candidates will be accepted from the floor on the day of the assembly, provided that the candidates present a written confirmation at the assembly, duly signed by the President or the Secretary General of their Gymnastics Federation.

25. WORKSHOPS / ROUND TABLE ON MEDICAL ASPECTS AND FIGHT AGAINST DOPING

Information on the MAG and WAG Workshops as well as the Round table on Medical aspects and fight against Doping during these World Championships will be included in the workplan.
